Typical tasks and activities to expect within this role include all types of hydrogeological field work including installation of wells; logging of rock core and soil types; collection of environmental quality samples; and directing and overseeing drilling contractors. You will also be involved in the detailed analysis of data, development of conceptual site models, and may carry out groundwater flow and contaminant transport modeling. Knowledge and experience with analyzing the effects of climate change on groundwater resources and knowledge of modeling software such as MODFLOW would be assets for the position.

What you Bring

- Theoretical knowledge and practical experience in contaminant and physical hydrogeology including drilling/installing of monitoring wells, hydraulic conductivity testing, development of conceptual site models, groundwater/contaminant transport and modeling.
- Master's degree in Hydrogeology with a Bachelor degree in Geology, Geological Engineering, or Earth Sciences. Course work must include both physical and contaminant hydrogeology.
- Eligibility for registration as a Professional Geologist or Engineer in BC.
- Strong, Clear and Concise Communication and Written Skills.
- Valid Class 5 drivers license with access to a vehicle.
- Curiosity to learn and gain technical knowledge from your peers and mentors and confident with sharing thoughts and ideas for improvement.
- Willingness to travel and when necessary work overtime to meet project schedules.
